**OUTSTANDING  
CANDIDATES**

Texas candidates who passed all parts of the examination at their initial sitting within 12 months from their initial testing date and earned the 10 highest cumulative scores will be recognized. In addition, any winners of the AICPA's Elijah Watt Sells award for outstanding achievement on the examination will be recognized.

**FIFTY-YEAR  
AWARDS**

The Board will honor individuals who have been licensed for 50 years. This was first done in June 1998 and is one of the highlights of the ceremony.

**CERTIFICATE  
PRESENTATION**

At the appropriate time, licensees will be directed to the stage. They will submit the *Oath of Office* and will be presented with their CPA certificate by Board members. After the certificates are presented, licensees will return to their seats via the opposite aisle.

## **FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS**

### **Where is the Palmer Events Center?**

The Palmer Events Center is located at 900 Barton Springs Rd, Austin, TX 78704. We will be in Exhibit Hall 2.

### **What should I wear to the ceremony?**

Semi-formal business attire is encouraged since this is a very special event.

### **Is there a limit on the number of guests I can bring?**

Due to space constraints, we ask that you please limit guests to no more than 10. We do not need to know their names.

### **Will my guests need tickets to attend?**

No. Tickets are not required for entry to the ceremony.

### **How long will the ceremony last?**

The ceremony typically last about an hour and a half.

### **Is it difficult to find parking?**

Parking can become very congested, especially closer to the event start time. There are two parking garages at the Palmer Events Center. The Riverside Drive garage entrance tends to be less congested. There are elevators and handicapped parking in the garage.

### **How much does parking cost? Can I pay with a credit/debit card?**

Parking is \$12 per vehicle, cash or debit/credit.

### **What time should I arrive?**

Doors open at 8:45 a.m. and we recommend arriving early to allow plenty of time to find parking and for candidates to find their assigned seats.
